George Washington Academy Guidelines for Entering Fourth Grade

Students entering fourth grade at George Washington Academy should have mastered the following academic, social, and behavioral milestones before entering school.

Language Arts:

- Basic understanding of the following parts of speech: nouns, pronouns, verbs, helping verbs, adjectives, adverbs, prepositions.
- All assignments are to be completed in cursive writing.
- Cursive letters should all sit on the line.
- Control over correct size of letters.
- Reading level should be at a 740 Lexile score.

<u>Math:</u>

- 3 digit addition and subtraction skills including borrowing. Basic multiplication and division facts.
- General understanding of fractions and how to reduce fractions.
- Time and Money skills.

Behaviorally:

- All 4th Grade students at GWA should be responsible for his or her own actions as well as their own property.
- Students should be respectful and kind to others as well as their teachers.
- Students should know how to properly care for themselves in regards to personal hygiene.

Homework Expectations:

- 1 hour of Homework plus 30 minutes of reading.
- Planners will be sent home nightly, reviewed and signed parents verifying that all
 of the homework has been completed, and returned the next day.
