

Math Advancement Procedure



George Washington Academy uses Into Math from HMH to provide math instruction to our students. Beginning in 6th grade, students have the opportunity to advance a grade level in math through participating in 7th grade math or utilizing BYU independent study courses.

The following criteria must be met for students to advance one grade level ahead of their current placement in the area of math:

-Students who are seeking an advanced placement for 6th Grade must have received a 4 or an above benchmark score on the RISE end of year summative assessment for grades 4, and 5.

-Students who are seeking an advanced placement for 7th Grade must have received a 4 or an above benchmark score on the RISE end of year summative assessment for grades 5, and 6.

When the above criteria are met, the GWA Assessment Director will work with 5th grade and 6th grade students at the end of every year to provide an end of year standards based assessment to the students that qualify. Students who perform at 85% or above will have the opportunity to meet with their parents and administration to discuss the expectations for math advancement and if it is a right fit for their child.

Enrichment will be provided to all students that show mastery in various math skills through our intervention/extension time, Patriot Time.
