

Academic and Behavior Goals for Entering First Grade at George Washington Academy

Language Arts:

- Write first name
- Know letter names and sounds
- Read CVC (consonant-vowel-consonant) words
- Recognize tricky words (high-frequency sight words)
- Read simple sentences
- Write a complete sentence

Math:

- Orally count to 100
- Identify and write numbers from 1-20, in numerical and random order
- Label basic shapes and colors
- Perform single digit addition through numeral 10
- Perform single digit subtraction through numeral 10

Behavior:

- Follow simple 2-3 step directions independently
- Listen and articulate at an appropriate age level
- Maintain age appropriate “attention” during instruction periods
- Exhibit the independent motor skills regarding: getting dressed, tying shoelaces, putting work in folders, completing work, walking independently to class, using school tools appropriately and safely (pencils, crayons, markers, rulers, scissors, glue, etc.)
