School Plan 2017-2018 - George Washington Academy

Goal #1 Goal

Four years ago GWA set a goal to improve technology use by both the teachers and students. This year we are expanding the use of our funds from technology to student experience. We will provide after school tutoring and more monies to go towards educational field trips. We will dedicate Landtrust as follows: 60% to Technology 20% to after school camps and 20% to Science and STEM learning. As a result we have significantly upgraded classroom technology and implemented the use of student computers throughout the school. The reports we have received from our teachers is across the board positive. The older grades have used Chromebooks to implement resources, deliver assignments and track student progress. The technology provides students with access to their work and resources from anywhere and at anytime. the younger grades have used student devices for mostly language arts and reading. GWA purchased interactive software to provide personal one on one lesson for each student. Our first goal is to have one Chromebook for every two students within the 3rd-8th grades. We feel that by increasing the availability of student devices teachers will be better able to pace tasks for their students, provide specific resources outside of the school and lastly assess and assign specific goals to each student. Our second goal is to begin the implementation of six tablets into each K-2nd grade classrooms. to begin the teachers will use the devices for both high and low students who need additional help and challenges.

Measurements

GWA will measure this goal by first auditing the qty of computers available to students compared to the amount of students by each grade level to ensure we can meet our one computer to two student goal.

We will also conduct an audit to ensure we increase our tablet use for grades K-2 for a total of five per classroom.

We will survey teachers and ensure they have enough support and knowledge to adequately use the chrome books and tablets in the classroom.

GWA's goal is to directly impact each student within their specific needs. We will monitor Google Classroom and use this information to collaborate with grade level teachers, share best practices and implement new uses that meet both high and low student needs.

Action Plan Steps

Steve Erickson will research Chrome Book and Tablet pricing and conduct the current inventory audit. Once this is completed Steve will order the Chrome Books and Tablets.

The next step will be to secure the chromebooks using a charging cart and then assign the carts to the appropriate grade levels.

Lastly Steve and Admin will provide ongoing support and training for teachers to increase the use of this technology within the classroom.

In this way we will support both low and high students. Data will be taken to show student growth before and after participation in these activities. Additionally, teacher and parent feedback will be sought.
