

530 – Videos & Instructional Electronic Communication Procedure



Electronic communications media includes, but is not limited to internet streaming, movies, videos, and disks. Electronic communications media may be used in a school/classroom when it relates directly to a subject being studied, correlates with Utah State Standards, and serves to enhance and enrich student learning.

Administrative Procedures:

1. All approved movies are to be shown using the streaming service provided by George Washington Academy (GWA).
2. 'G' rated movies are permitted in all classrooms, as they are related to the curriculum and/or state standards.
3. Students will be allowed to view videos or movies with a rating of 'PG' only with written permission from the students' parents, as they are related to the curriculum and/or state standards.
4. Films with a rating higher than 'PG' are prohibited in the school.
5. Movies and/or streamed videos that are 'Unrated' may not be shown without previous screening by the teacher and approval from the Executive Director.
6. YouTube is permitted with use of video monitoring software, as it relates to the curriculum and/or state standards.
7. If a parent does not want their child to view the movie that is being shown in class an alternative assignment or project will be assigned to the student and an alternative setting will be provided.
8. Students excused from viewing electronic media may not be penalized in any way.
9. Video games are not allowed.
