## **Financial Report**:

Spencer Adams gave the report. He said that we are 33% of the way through the fiscal year. The true up is coming soon, we won't see that until the November allotment. So next month when we look at this the majority of the true ups will be reflected in the state revenue line. Ratios are looking very healthy. Every month this fiscal year, there has been more revenue than expenses. Once we see the true ups come in the state revenues will bump up as well. 

## Situation:

As part of our ongoing technology hardware replacement plan, we continue to replace older Chromebooks with newer, more reliable models. Over time, Chromebooks experience reduced battery life, slower performance, and limited compatibility with updated software, all of which can hinder instruction and student productivity. By maintaining a consistent replacement cycle, we ensure that students have access to fast, functional devices that support modern learning tools and online assessments. This proactive approach minimizes classroom disruptions, reduces long-term repair costs, and helps us maintain a high standard of technology readiness across the school.

## Background Information, including a list of reviewing committees:

The technology committee has developed a five-year hardware replacement plan to ensure our devices remain reliable and effective for classroom use. As part of this plan, we replace aging Chromebooks each year to maintain consistent performance and support instructional needs. The funding for this portion of the replacement cycle will come from two sources—the Digital Teaching and Learning Grant and the Land Trust Grant. Our Chromebooks have worked so hard this year that even they put 'new devices' on their holiday wish list—time to spread a little tech cheer with our yearly replacements!
