

Per State Public Health Order and Executive Order from the Governor of Utah in effect until the statewide K-12 Mask Mandate has been removed or modified, GWA will be complying by this mandate by adopting the following practices related to the wearing of face coverings for all students and employees.

A face covering is a cloth mask without holes that covers the mouth and nose of the individual wearing the mask.

When a student, by his own choice or at the direction of a parent, refuses to comply with the mask requirement, GWA is legally able to exclude the student from in person school.

GWA is offering an online education alternative to help assist families or individuals that may not be able to wear a face covering during the school day.

All students and staff will wear a face covering while on campus unless specified under the exemption of the Governor's mandate. Students will be required to have a note from an MD, DO, PA, NP in order to be exempt. This must be turned into the Health and Wellness Secretary and she will communicate the exemption to all applicable staff.

All visitors will check-in with the front office staff through specified doors and direction markers and be required to wear a mask. A mask will be available for all visitors who do not have one.

A student that has an IEP or 504 accommodation that relates to the medical exemption in regards to a mask will not need to have the IEP or 504 accommodation rewritten to include this exemption.
