

## Math Procedure – Student Advancement

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In the first 6 weeks of school all students will be monitored on their academic performance in Math. If the student's performance is deemed advanced or above level a Saxon End of Course Exam will be administered by the teacher. If a student performs at 87% or above on the End of Course Exam of their assigned grade level students will have the opportunity to advance one Saxon Math Course ahead. Students may not be moved without a required meeting with parents, teachers and administration, administrative approval, and completed paperwork.

All math course changes involving advancement must be made within the first six weeks of school or for incoming students within the first trimester. Teachers and administrators will continue to monitor the success of each individual child to ensure that the placement was appropriate. If there is a reason for an exception to this procedure it needs to be approved through the child's parents and the school administration.
